Homi Bhabha Science Talent exam, 01 student has qualified for the first round.

In Science Olympiad total 135 students participated, 12 students have qualified.

In the Scholarship exam conducted by Maharashtra State 18 students of Std V & 10 students of Std VIII appeared for the exam. Out of that 1 student from std V & 3 students from std VIII are qualified.

An Educational Presentation of HEALTH AND HYGIENE was conducted by "SAVLON SWASTH INDIA MISSION."

ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE FIELD OF EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:
